

Stewart Island Residents Parking Card

Debit Card Instructions

The Stewart Island residents parking card works like a debit card, you top up the card and then use it to enter and exit the carpark. Your card will be deducted on each EXIT of the carpark.

- Initially the card is only activated on the first entrance into the carpark.
- Topping up your card is done via the carparking pay machines located inside the terminal.
- The carparking fee is currently \$12 per exit.
- The card MUST be used at the entrance of the car park – DO NOT take a paper ticket. This means the system knows you are in the carpark.
- \$25 bond to be paid on issue of the card.
- \$50 for a replacement card

Conditions of Use

- The Stewart Island Residents parking card is for permanent Stewart Island residents only.
- The card will be held under the name and car registration of the person on the application form.
- The Card cannot be given to anyone else for use i.e. visitors or guests such as Airbnb.
- If you no longer require your card or have moved off Stewart Island, your bond will be refunded when the card is returned to Invercargill Airport Office.

If any of the above conditions of use are not being met it will result in the card being cancelled. IAL reserves the right to change these conditions of use at any time.
